IMPORTANT INFORMATION



CDC GUIDELINES AND CENTER PANDEMIC POLICIES

- Center hours will remain 7:00AM-5:00PM until further notice.
- Drop off hours are 7:00AM-9:30AM.
- One parent per drop off. Staff will let you in the building.
- Temperatures will be taken when you enter the building.
- No bookbags, cloth bags: Please use **plastic bags only** for belongings.
- Provide disposable cold lunches; label **ALL** items.
- CENTER shoes must be left here to use daily (will be sanitized in evenings).
- Continue to wear masks for ages 2 and up.
- All mail/correspondence will be sent through telephone or HiMama, including invoices.
- The Center will continue to practice social distancing to the best of our ability.
- Staff will wash toys after each use. We sanitize frequently.
