Born in Kaunas, Lithuania in 1878, Anna Jasulis came to this country in 1905 and settled in Chicago. In 1906 she entered the Sisters of the Holy Family to be known in religion as Sister Mary Calasanta.

She served in the capacity of Superior, Teacher and Seamstress. She particularly enjoyed her catechetical and sacristy work.
