Born in Lithuania, Magdalen Krungel came to the United States at the outbreak of World War I and soon thereafter entered the Congregation of the Sisters of the Holy Family. Invested in the habit of the Congregation, she was known as Sister M. Barbara. In 1922, she transferred to Millvale in the company of 14 other pioneer professed sisters.

Sister continued in her ministry in the kitchen and laundry until 1960 when because of failing health, she became a member of the Ministry of Prayer.
