Ministry:

Sister Joseph Mary was born Anne McCaskey in Brooklyn, NY. After graduation she spent several years doing clerical work in New York. Having confided to her cousin, Rev. J. Sutkaitis, Pastor at SS Peter and Paul Church in Elizabeth, NJ of her desire to enter religious life, he directed her to the newly formed sisterhood in Pittsburgh, PA.

In those early days of the community, study and teaching were done simultaneously. Her first assignment was teaching 6th grade at St. Casimir's School on the South Side of Pittsburgh. She spent six years in Elizabeth, NJ as Principal/Superior and then studied one year at Duquesne University as a full time student. Later Dubois, Detroit, Philadelphia and Maspeth saw her ministry. In 1967, when her health began to fail, she was transferred to the Motherhouse infirmary where she was a Minister of Prayer until her death on October 25, 1972.
