While a Sister of the Holy Family, Johanna was called Sister Vitolda. She entered into the community of the Sisters of the Holy Family from St. Hedwig Church in East Cambridge, Massachusetts, entering from Des Plaines, Illinois. In 1923 she became a novice with the Sisters of St. Francis in Millvale.



Her many years of housekeeping duties began in 1920 and her assignments included Chicago, Detroit, Kenosha, Esplen, Homestead, Elizabeth, NJ, Mahanoy City and various convents in the Pittsburgh area, as well as in Philadelphia, Rochester, East St. Louis and Cleveland, Ohio. She was stationed in Cleveland from 1958 until 1969. After two years in dietary in Homestead from 1970 until 1972 she returned to the Motherhouse where she assumed minimal duties until her death on May 8, 1972.
