Sister Veronica began her postulancy at SS Petet & Paul in Elizabeth, New Jersey. She taught at St. Anthony's in Detroit; St. Casimir in Kansas; Holy Trinity in Hartford, SS Peter & Paul in Homestead; St. Peter's in Kenosha; St. Joseph in DuBois and St. Casimir in Pgh.

She was actively involved in many roles in addition to that of teaching for over 20 years.

She began experiencing problems with her mobility which finally forces her, in June of 1948, to terminate her teaching ministry.

In 1950 Sister Veronica was diagnosed as a confirmed victim of multiple sclerosis. From the time of the onset of her illness until her death in 1977, Sister bore this debilitating disease with courage and patience.
