Sister Augustine was admitted to the postulancy with the Sisters of the Holy Family of Nazareth. A year later she moved to the Franciscan Community in Millvale, PA. She received the Franciscan habit in 1924 at Mt. Alverna and made her first profession at Mt. Providence.

She was a teacher for 25 years and also served as an organist in various parish churches. She was instrumental in developing the format for the Medical Records Department at Good Samaritan Hospital in Illinois where she worked for 27 years. She served as secretary for four years to the Franciscan Fathers of Kennebunkport, Maine as well as acting secretary for several of the community's General Chapters.
