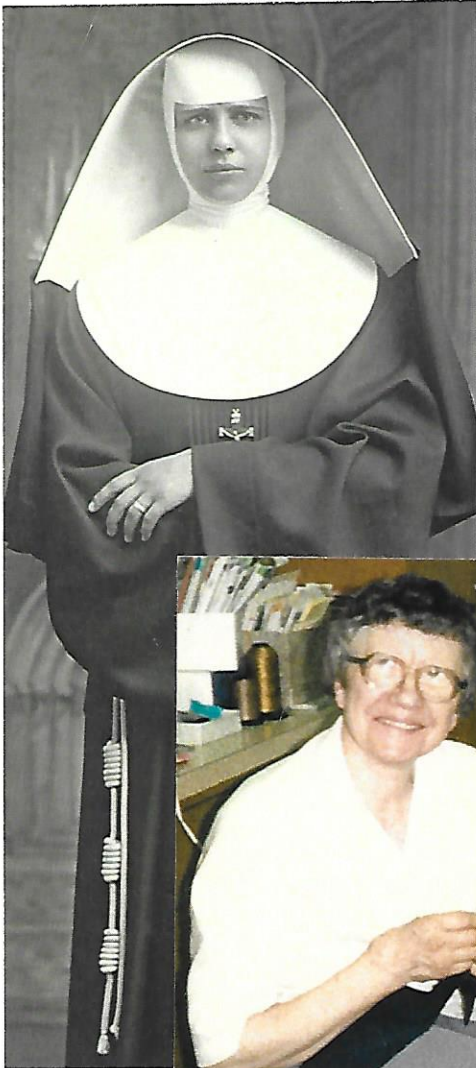


***Sister M. Dominica Daubaris***

Though she was born in Chicago, the family returned to Lithuania. When she was 19, Stella returned to the USA and entered the community from Cicero, Illinois.

Sister M. Dominica served the community in dietary work and later as a seamstress. The greatest portion of her active ministerial life was spent serving the needs of the Motherhouse Community. However, two other places of ministry were Homestead, PA and Grand Rapids, MI. Sister Dominica changed her ministry late in life. When she felt that her strength was gradually diminishing, she asked to study sewing and completed a course at the Clarissa School of Design. From then until her death, Sister Dominica served in the Motherhouse as seamstress. She also offered tailoring classes to outsiders.
