Sister M. Francita spent most of young life in Detroit, Michigan. She enrolled in the St. Francis Academy Prep School in June of 1931 with both Sister Giles and Sister Assisi.

She taught for 34 years at all grade levels. Some of the places she taught were St. Casimir's on the South Side, Cleveland and DuBois, PA. In Hartford, Connecticut she taught at Holy Trinity High School as well as South Catholic High School. Back in Pittsburgh, she taught at Canevin High, St. Francis Academy as well as South Side Catholic High School.

In 1970 she enrolled in St. Joseph's Hospital in Houston, Texas in order to study Medical Records. Thus, began a new ministry. For the next twenty years Sisters worked in the Medical Records Department at Good Samaritan Hospital in Mt. Vernon, Illinois.
