Sister Rosalia entered the community from SS Peter and Paul Parish in Elizabeth, New Jersey.

She began her teaching career at St. Vincent de Paul School in Esplen, PA in 1927 teaching 1st and 2nd graders. Her entire teaching career was devoted to nurturing those students who were just beginning their formal education---from Kindergarten through Grades 3.

Her assignments took her to Cleveland, Ohio and Esplen, Pennsylvania. She taught the 1st graders at St. Gabriel's in Whitehall from 1951 until 1968.

Although she officially retired in 1968, she continued to be actively involved in various duties at the Motherhouse until 1982 when she began her years as a prayer apostolate. In 1989 she became of Minister of Prayer until her death on December 17, 1990.
