Ministry:

Sister Assumpta began her ministry at St. Joseph's School in DuBois, Pennsylvania teaching high school students. In 1938 she returned to Pittsburgh teaching 9th and 10th graders at St. Francis Academy and St. Casimir High School on the Southside.

In 1948 she began a new ministry as secretary at the Franciscan Monastery in Kennebunkport, Maine. From 1951 until 1958 she worked in one of the offices at Good Samaritan Hospital in Mt. Vernon, Illinois.

She resumed her teaching career in 1958 in Kenosha, Wisconsin teaching 5th and 6th graders. Between 1962 to 1968 she served as both Principal and Teacher to 6th grade students.

She returned to Good Samaritan in 1971 again doing clerical work. In 1974, she assumed new responsibilities as Patient Visitor and Pastoral Care in Alton, Illinois. She also assisted in Spiritual care in Good Samaritan from 1984 through 1989. In 1989 she returned to the Motherhouse as a Minister of Prayer until her death in 1995.
