Following her formative years in the congregation, Sister M. Anne was assigned to Holy Trinity in Hartford, CT to teach 4th grade. That lasted about a month. She came down with typhoid fever and returned to the Motherhouse to recuperate for the remainder of the year 1937.

Her teaching career spanned over 50 years, 6 of which were coupled with principalship in Moon Run, 3 in Kenosha, and her last 3 years in education as principal of James Lavelle School in West Mifflin, PA. Sister M. Anne also taught in the following schools and parishes: St. Francis Academy in Whitehall; St. George in Cleveland, OH; SS Peter & Paul in Grand Rapids, MI; Holy Trinity, Moon Run, PA; St. Gabriel, Pittsburgh, PA; Immaculate Conception in E. St. Louis, IL; and St. Valentine, Bethel Park, PA.

After her years of teaching, Sister worked for four years at Good Samaritan Hospital as a patient representative. When the sponsorship of the hospital transferred to the SSM community, she returned to the Motherhouse and continued working as receptionist. Then, in her last 5 years of ministry to the community, she fulfilled the duties of postal clerk, manager of the convent Mailing Department, and coordinator of Cluster 3 S in Assisi Hall.
