In 1932 Sister M. Petronella began the work that she would do for the whole of her religious life--that of housekeeping, dietary and laundry services. She served in these capacities first at St. Peter's in Kenosha, WI. Her next 3-year assignment was at St. Casimir's in Kansas City, KS. In 1937 she came to work in our convents in Pennsylvania: 3 years at St. Vincent de Paul's in Esplen; 3 years at St. Joseph's in DuBois,

In 1943 she was changed from a parish setting to work in the dietary department of Good Samaritan Hospital, at Mt. Vernon, IL. The following year she was needed at Holy Trinity Convent in Hartford, CT. In 1945-47 Sister M. Petronella went again to St. Joseph's in DuBois for 2 years, to St. Peter's in Kenosha for 3 years, and then to St. Vincent de Paul's in Esplen for 6 years. In 1957-61, she served the Sisters at SS. Peter & Paul Parish in Grand Rapids, MI. From 1961 on, Petey (as she was lovingly called) remained in Pennsylvania. Her service record shows the following sequence of assignments from 1961 to 2002:
