Sister Agnes Kathryn celebrated almost 91 years on this earth of which 72+ years were spent as a member of the community where she taught in mission schools throughout the United States. Her love of teaching became even more widely acclaimed when she began directing the R-T-R program on the campus of the Motherhouse.
