Sister Jean's ministries were in the field of education for a period of 44 years during which time she taught first grade to scores of little ones in 12 schools, 8 cities and 6 sections of Pittsburgh. She taught from coast to coast—from Los Angeles CA to Elizabeth NJ.

Her second ministry was at Good Samaritan Hospital in Mt. Vernon, Illinois where she assumed entirely new roles as a nurse aid, clerk typist, and Assistant to the President as well as hospital archivist. Upon her return to the Motherhouse she served as receptionist and clerical assistant until she began her ministry of prayer in 2000.
