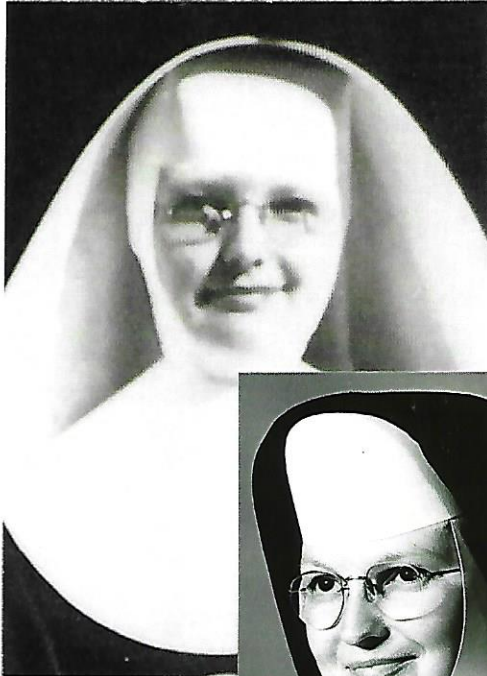


Sister M. Felicita Butrim

Sister Felicita was a full-time teacher for fifty years. The schools at which she taught were located in Michigan, California, Ohio, Pennsylvania, New Jersey and Illinois. After that time, with diminished hearing, Sister Felicita moved to part-time ministry as a pre-school aide, tutor and a school assistant. She served in some of these schools more than once. In 2003 she returned to Pittsburgh where she continued to serve in the craft room and also devote her time to prayer.

While still teaching Sister Felicita gave retreats and lectured on St. Francis, contributed articles to the Belleview Catholic Newspaper, and also wrote for the *Catholic Teachers Review*. She also taught Lithuanian at the Lithuanian Club on the South Side of Pittsburgh for eight years.

Sister Felicita continually enriched herself through reading, retreats and lectures. She is remembered as a gentle, kind, loving woman who loved God and all of God's creation.
