*April 2, 1931 - November 30, 2013*

Sister Claudete was born in Serrana City – São Paulo on April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 1931. She was the only girl among the four children.



She entered to the Congregation in 1958. In 1960 she was in charge of the boarding school and the Aspirants, a job that she held until 1962. After her final vows she continued her academic studies and began to study music, standing out in piano. At the same time she worked in Saint Joseph Parish – Vila Zelina, with catechism for children and sacristans. In 1974 she was transferred to Pio XII Community, and worked in the maintenance department of Pio XII School until 1991.

From 1992 to 2000 she held the duties of treasurer. In 2001 due to her mother's fragile health, she was transferred to St. Michael the Archangel Community in order to be closer to her and take care of her.

From 2002 on she held various positions in Saint Michael the Archangel School. Over the next few years she helped with the maintenance, cafeteria, bookstore, and archives of the school. Sister also prepared the decorations for parties and feast days. She joyfully accomplished the works she was asked to do.
