

Sister Antonieta - Adele Ambrosevicius
October 3, 1925 - June 24, 2014



Sister Antonieta was born October 3, 1925 in Pepaliai, Kaunas, Lithuania. She came to Brazil as a child and joined the Congregation on June 13, 1942.

During her formative years she worked as a teacher for children, from first to fourth grades.

She professed her final vows in January 27, 1948 and continued teaching until 1966. In 1967 she was transferred to Pedro Leopoldo – Minas Gerais, to work in our Hospital. She also worked at the Immaculate Conception Parish as a catechist. She worked with accounting and public relations until 1980. She was transferred to Vila Zelina Sao Paulo in 1989 to work at Saint Michel the Archangel School.

Sister also resided and worked in Vila Alpina serving at Our Lady of Mount Carmel School. In both schools she served as Public Relations, besides helping in the canteens of the schools, and coordinating maintenance and purchases.

From 1984 to 1987 she served as Regional Councilor. In 2004 she had the opportunity and the joy to travel to her homeland being accompanied by her blood sister, Sofia.

In 2008 Sister Antonieta celebrated her Diamond Jubilee, with a very beautiful ceremony, which made her very happy. Two days later she suffered a brain aneurysm. She underwent surgery, but never regained her health. After leaving the hospital, she was transferred to Recanto Paz e Bem, where she stayed until the end of her life.
